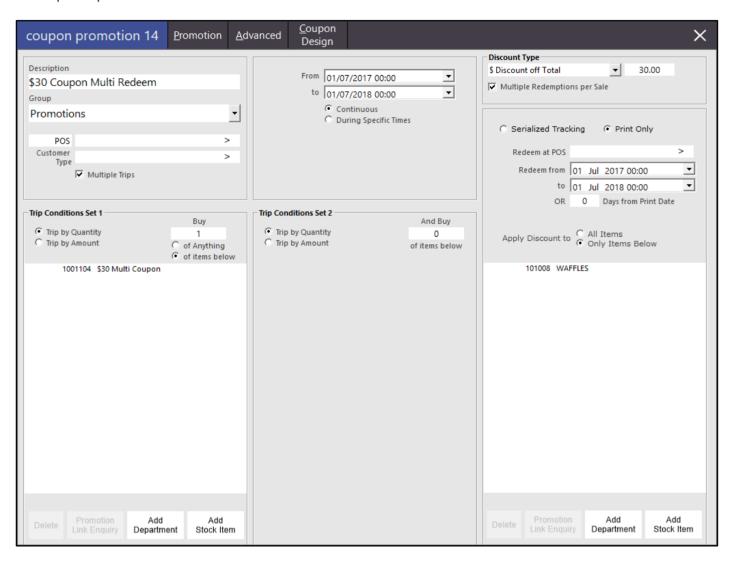


Coupons

Multiple Coupon Redemptions in a \$ Discount Off Total Promotion

This promotion is configured in such a way that if you redeem multiple discounted items within the one sale, and the coupon's value is worth more than the total of those discounted items, they will all be discounted only up to the value of those items.

Go to File > Sales > Promotions > Coupons > Add > Discount Type: \$ Discount off Total > Select: Multiple Redemptions per Sale.

Once a successful send occurs, the background process will go and attempt to resend any failed messages in the queue.



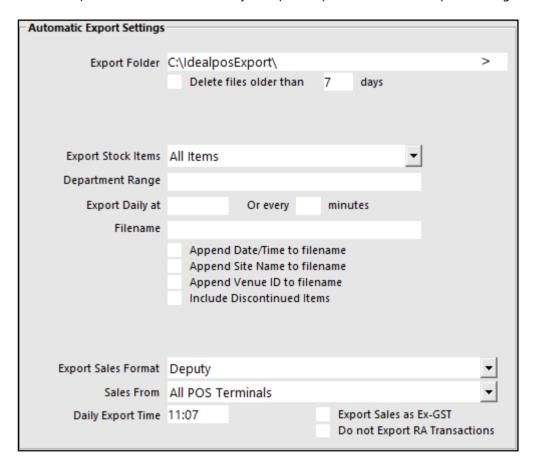
Deputy Export

Deputy export: options to exclude RA accounts and to report on Ex-GST amounts

Deputy uses the sales data to work out the wage cost as a percentage of revenue. Most businesses work out wage cost targets as a percentage of net revenue. So, it is the net revenue (Ex-GST) amount that needs to be reported to Deputy. Gratuity figures are currently included in the sales data. This makes the reported wage percentage inaccurate (especially for venues that generate larger gratuities). The option to not export RA will include Gift Voucher sales.

Two new options have been added when exporting to Deputy to allow you to select if these options get exported.

Go to Setup > POS Terminals > Modify > Import/Export > Automatic Export Settings > Export Sales Format: Deputy.





IBA Interface

IBA Promotions Import - Exclude Batch option

A new option has been added to allow you to exclude a specific zone area when importing promotion files from IBA. You need to add the 3 characters that designates which zone you want to exclude.

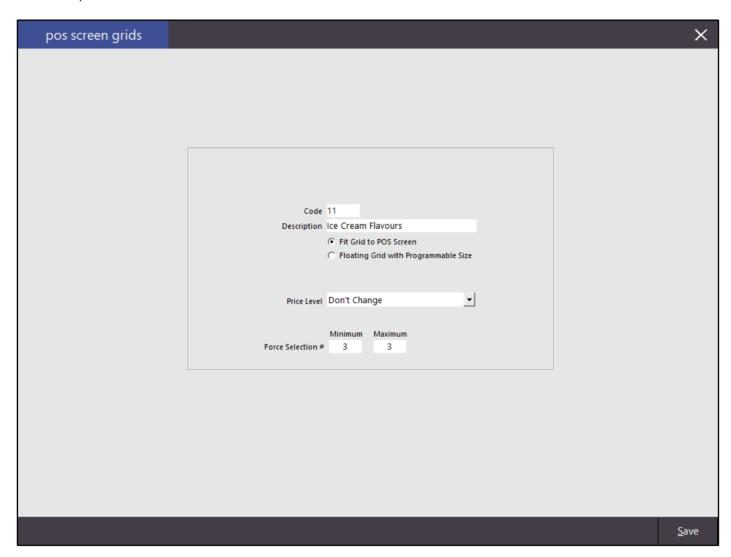

POS Screen Grids

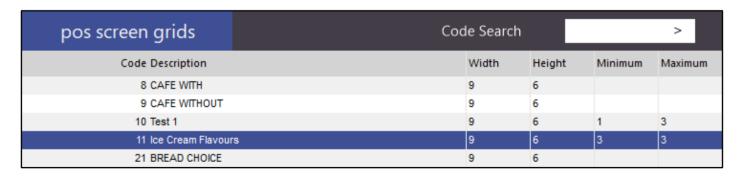
POS Grids - Force Selection with Minimum and Maximum options

This feature allows you to configure the exact number of items the operator is expected to press before being allowed to move on.

Go to Setup > POS Screen > Grids > Add.



Go to the Grid list > Select your Grid in the list.

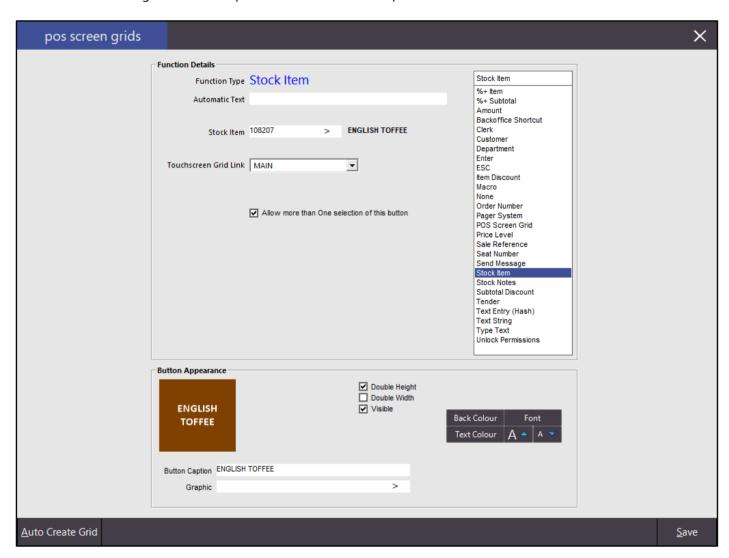


Press Items > Add all the required stock items in this grid, in this example, Ice Cream Flavours. It can also be used for Pizzas and Sandwiches where a maximum number of items are added for free.

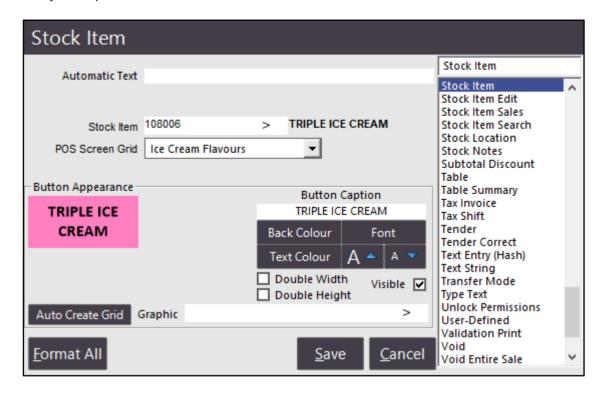
Touch Screen Grid Link – This function will only work on the last item selected on the grid. If you require the operator to go to another grid after selecting the last item, you need to add the grid link to all items as you cannot know which one it will be.

Allow more than One selection of this button – This checkbox allows the operator to select multiple of a single item, if required. In the example of ice cream flavours, it's especially so, however this might not always be the case.

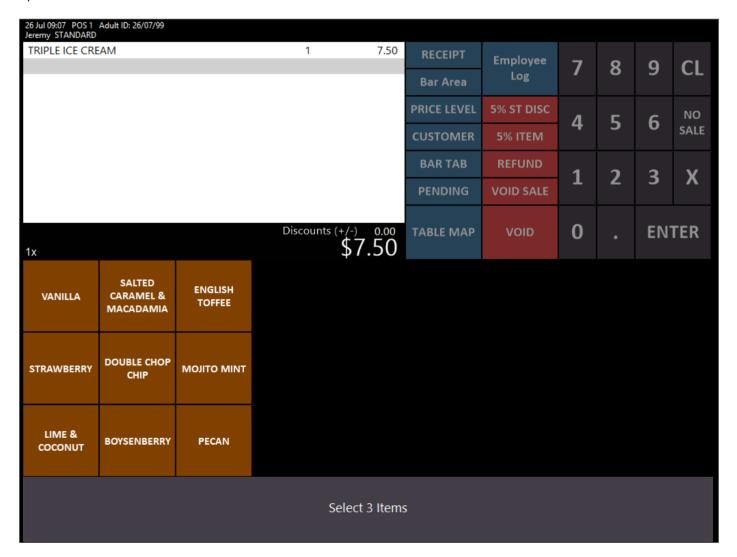
Items included in the grid can have a price allocated to them as per usual.



Link your Triple Ice Cream button to the Ice Cream Flavours Grid.



On the POS Screen press the Triple Ice Cream button. The item will be charged and the Ice Cream Flavours grid will open.



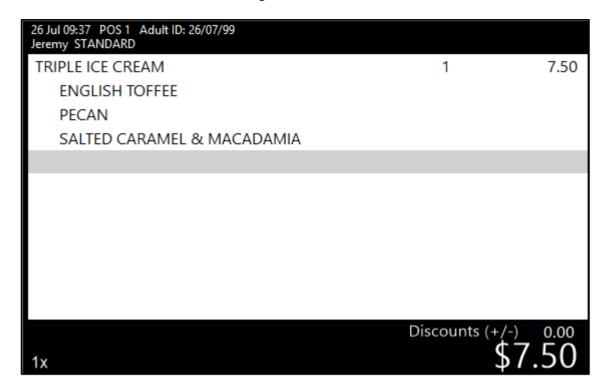
The bottom of the grid will tell you how many items you need to select, in this example, 3. Once an item is selected (English Toffee), a count will display on the button as to how many of that flavour has been selected. The bottom of the grid will show how many items are yet to be selected.



The second item will also show the count decreasing.

As soon as the last choice is selected the grid will exit to the main screen or touchscreen grid you selected for the item to go to. You cannot access the grid again unless you have it on the POS screen, or re-select the main item. If you make a mistake, void the sale and start again.



You cannot add multiple quantities of the main item as it will not select the same quantities of the choices available. If multiple of the same item is required, you have to do them one at a time.

Zebra Label support for Kitchen Printers

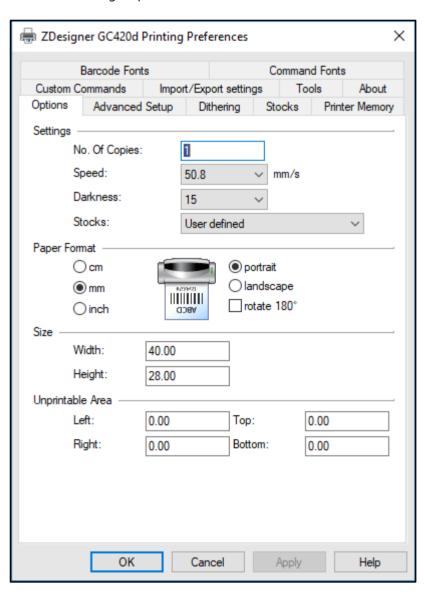
This feature allows you to print a label which can placed on the product for the dispense to the correct customer. This will be beneficial mostly in fast food and convenience stores, where people order take-away that can take a few minutes to prepare. When you order a kebab, fish and chips or Chinese, your meals can have a sticker on them with the order details, so you can confirm that it is your order before you open it. The staff dispensing the meal to the customer might not be the one preparing it, so it allows for errors to be minimal.

Setup Zebra Printer

To be able to use this functionality, you will need to have a ZDesigner GC420d printer. The following label sizes have been configured to test with:

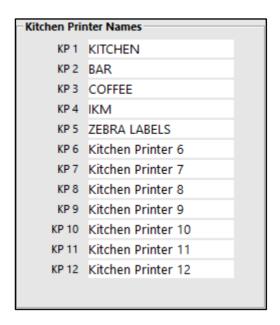

Once you have connected the printer, do a test print through Windows. You may need to calibrate the position of the information that gets printed to ensure all the information is visible.

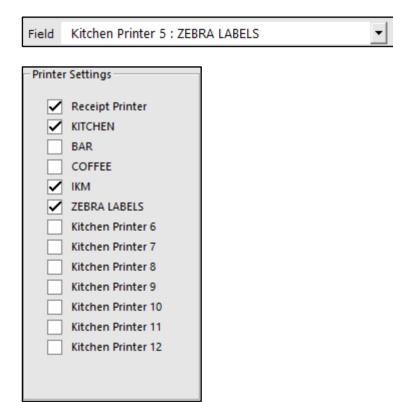

The new import fields need to be specified in the Header. They can be: CUSTOMER_TYPE, CUSTOMERTYPE, CUSTOMERTYPERANGE, CUSTOMER_TYPE_RANGE, POS, POS_NUMBER, TERMINAL, POS_RANGE, LOCATION, LOCATION_RANGE, SITE, SITE_RANGE, PRICE_LEVEL

As the POS Range, Location Range, Site Range, Price Level all share the same field, whichever field comes first will take precedence if you have a record that has data in both fields.

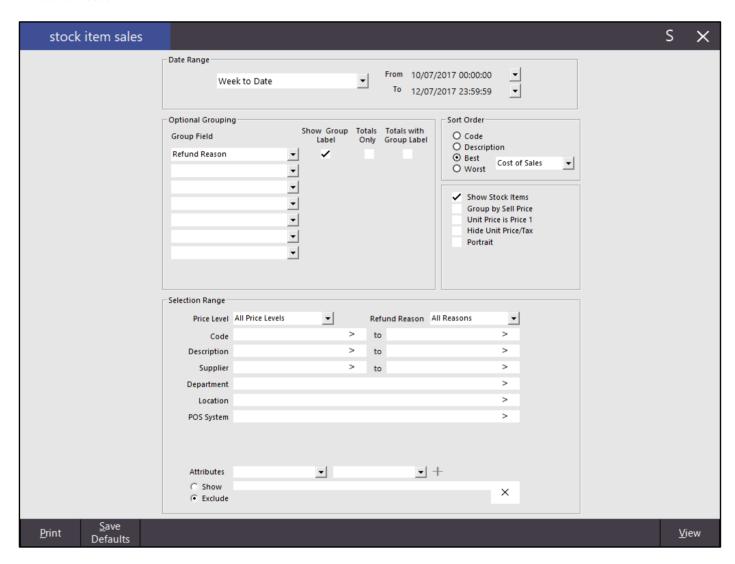

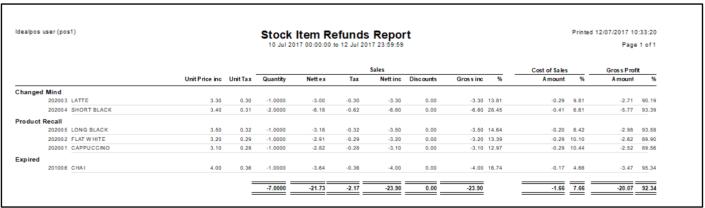
Refunds

Large retail venues can process a lot of refunds and need to be able to see a pattern of product returns to act quickly to remove those items from sale in the event of a larger issue.

Go to Reports > Sales > Stock Item Sales > Optional Grouping: Refund Reason (untick Totals Only) > Selection Range > Refund Reason.
