## PLBPOS Interface

### IP-4312 – PLBPOS Interface – Ability to add credentials in Global Options

This function adds the ability to add PLBPOS Interface credentials in Global Options.

Any customers that are using the PLBPOS Interface will need to complete the below steps.

Go to: Back Office > Setup > Global Options > Interfaces > PLBPOS

When updating an existing site that already has PLBPOS enabled, ensure that the required details are entered into the following fields:

- Resource ID
- Client ID
- Client Secret

When configuring a new site, ensure that the above fields are configured, as well as the Tenant ID and CDC Prefixes.
